On-line chemistry



An illustrated, on-line version of the periodic table is to be launched on March 3, by the Royal Society of Chemistry.

It forms part of a joint visual arts and science project, *Visual Elements*.

The electronic periodic table has images of the elements themselves and their contribution to human life. Each of 109 elements has its own page.

The project also has a series of 16 "Periodic Landscapes" which are

computer-generated 3D panoramas following patterns in properties of the elements.
