

# International Chemistry Olympiad



Take part in this year's competition to test your knowledge of chemistry and compete for a chance to represent the UK at the 40th International Chemistry Olympiad in Budapest from 12th to 21st July 2008.

## Round One

A written test held at your school between 28th January and 15th February 2008. Gold, silver and bronze certificates will be awarded and the top 50 candidates will receive prizes.

## Round Two

Held at Cambridge University over the weekend of 28th to 30th March 2008.

This round involves both a written and a practical test. A team of four students plus one reserve candidate will be selected to represent the UK at the finals in Hungary.

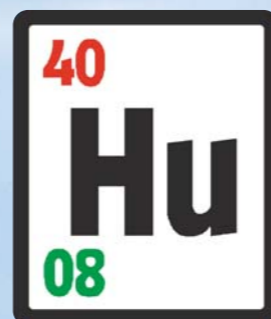
Ask your teacher to fill in the registration form they received with this poster and return it to:
