Applications are invited from Early Career Researchers* to participate in a 4 day workshop to be held at the Novotel Golf Resort and Convention Centre in Bogor, Indonesia from **26-29 January 2016**, under the Researcher Links programme funded by the British Council Newton Fund and the Royal Society of Chemistry. The objectives of the Workshop are to:

- Establish research links and future research collaborations between UK and Indonesian ECRs
- Contribute to capacity building for ECRs in both countries
- Support research areas relevant to the economic development of both countries

The Workshop will focus on 4 areas:

- Heterogeneous catalysis in the context of energy and the environment
- Photocatalysis
- Electrocatalysis
- Materials chemistry relevant to the above areas

All travel, accommodation and subsistence costs are covered by the British Council and RSC funding.
