Thank you for registering to attend the forthcoming RSC "Scottish" Dalton meeting, taking place on 2nd July 2018 here in Durham.

The meeting is taking place in the Department of Chemistry, which is located on the Science Site (off Stockton Road), No. 15 on the Durham Map (grid ref. E6), with the talks taking place in room CG85. The easiest way to enter the building is *via* the "red" greenhouse/atrium as indicated on the map (registration will take place just inside the door).

The meeting kicks off with registration at 9h30-10h25 and Introductions/Welcome at 10h25.

Unfortunately, parking is extremely limited in Durham/The University. Consequently, anyone coming by car should use the Park&Ride carpark at Howlands on the A177, which is about a 5-10 min walk from the Science Site (see Durham Map, grid ref. C9).

For those wishing to walk from the station to the Department, it is around a 25 minute walk either through the City centre or along the banks of the River Wear (see attached WalkMap). Alternatively, taxis are readily available at the station; ask for Durham University Science Site – Stockton Road entrance and ask to be dropped at the Security Barrier.
