REGISTRATION

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation reservations can be made at the symposium venue, the Village Hotel, Chilwell, Beeston, Nottingham. Accommodation booking and payment must be made directly with the hotel. A number of discounted rooms, at £75 per night, are available for BIAPWS Symposium participants and a booking code for these will be issued at the time of registration acknowledgement. Please bear in mind that the number of reserved rooms is limited and demand has exceeded supply in previous years so early booking is recommended.
