#### Flash Poster Talks

Each poster presenter will have a 3 minute flash presentation slot within the main programme. You should provide the organisers in advance with 1 PowerPoint slide and plan your poster introduction for 3 minutes – the timing will be strict!

The slide must be submitted to [sarah.hill@lgcgroup.com](mailto:sarah.hill@lgcgroup.com) by Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June at 12pm!

Key points to keep in mind for the flash talk:

- What is your main message?
- What is the problem?
- How will you solve it?
- Key results from your work that answer these questions.
- Try to use visuals for the slide, e.g. diagrams, charts, images, chromatograms, and minimise the amount of text.
- Practice the talk to ensure you are within 3 minutes!

Please hang your poster on the assigned board by 9.30am on Tuesday and be ready by your poster during the poster session.
