



5th EuChemS Inorganic Chemistry Conference

Moscow, 24-28 June 2019

Inorganic Chemistry is a buoyant subject area with major developments being seen in all branches of the subject and common themes emerging. The EuChemS Inorganic Chemistry Conference is a biannual event showcasing the latest work of the very best inorganic chemists. After previous meetings successfully held in Manchester (2011), Jerusalem (2013), Wroclaw (2015) and Copenhagen (2017), the 5th edition, EICC-5, will be organized in Moscow, Russia, on 24-28 June 2019. Guided by the traditions of previous EICCs, the conference main purpose is to promote the development of the new generation of inorganic chemists, enabling them to form new contacts with colleagues from different countries and chemistry fields through the presentation of their work, and through the many networking opportunities the conference will provide.

The conference will be organized in parallel sessions covering broadly

- Coordination and supramolecular chemistry
- Catalysis and organometallic chemistry
- Transition metal and main group chemistry
- f-Block chemistry
- Reaction mechanisms
- Computational chemistry
- Medicinal and bioinorganic chemistry
- Magnetochemistry
- Energy and photochemistry
- Inorganic and organoelement materials

The conference program will include plenary, invited and keynote lectures, oral, flash and poster presentations.

150th anniversary of the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements

On 20 December 2017, during its 72nd Session, the UN General Assembly proclaimed 2019 the International Year of the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements commemorating the 150th anniversary of one of the most important and influential achievements in modern science. EICC-5 is part of a year-long international celebration program endorsed by UNESCO.

Within the framework of the EICC-5 program, a roundtable discussion dedicated to the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements will be held.

EurJIC Special Issue

Selected contributions will be invited for publication in the special issue of the *European Journal of Inorganic Chemistry*. The microreviews, full papers, and short communications will be peer-reviewed and processed in the usual manner. The details are coming soon.
