Following the AGM there will be a talk, "Nanomedicine - making a big impact from small particles"
Dr Tom McDonald, Liverpool University

Tom, as part of a diverse team of scientists, has taken a HIV treatment from a small scale lab concept in the lab, to the first global example of a clinical trial of a HIV nanomedicine. Tom's talk will introduce nanotechnology, examine accuracy of the mainstreams' perception of nanomedicine and describe some of the research carried out at Liverpool.
