Please take a moment to familiarise yourself with our guidance below:



On arrival at MIRA please report to the gatehouse. You will be provided with a car parking pass which you should take time to read carefully. You will also be given a visitors badge, which should be worn so it's clearly visible.



Safety signs and Prohibited Area signs must be complied with at all times. Walkways should be used where they are provided. If a fire alarm sounds then please accompany your host to the nearest assembly area.



No Photography

Photography is not allowed on our site unless by specific prearrangement. All portable devices (mobile phones, laptops, tablets etc.) with cameras will have a temporary tamper evident sticker placed over the lens.



Safety footwear must be worn beyond this point

Most of our test areas require safety shoes to be worn. Please ensure that if you plan to visit these areas, that you can provide your own safety shoes or that you have discussed this with your host prior to your visit. Other PPE will be provided where required.

Our professional photographers can be used to record specific events whilst adhering to our security policy. Please ask your host for more details, prior to your arrival.



Please do not bring any hazardous materials on site. If you are unsure then please speak to your MIRA host who will seek further advice if required.



Our site max speed limit is 20 mph. On arrival at your destination a MIRA employee will escort you to your meeting.



Some of our facilities present an increased health risk to certain physiological conditions. If you have an implanted device, please make your host aware.



Visitors shall respect the confidentiality of others using the MIRA facilities and whilst on MIRA premises shall not approach or inspect any vehicle with which they are not specifically concerned.



Due to the nature of our business, animals and minors are prohibited from our site without the express permission of our Executive.

Directions

MIRA Nuneaton

From the North

M1 A. 1) At Junction 24 of the M1 take the A42 south (towards Birmingham). **2)** Where the A42 becomes the M42 (at Junction 11) take the A444 south towards Nuneaton. **3)** At the A5, turn left. MIRA Technology Park is on the left after 0.5 mile.

M1 B. 1) Continue south to Junction 21 of the M1 and take the M69 towards Coventry. **2)** Then, take the A5 (Junction 1 of the M69) heading north towards Tamworth. **3)** Continue on the A5 over three roundabouts following signs for Tamworth. At the first traffic light junction continue straight-on and over the next roundabout. MIRA Technology Park is then on your right after about 0.75 mile.

From the South

M1. 1) At Junction 18 of the M1 take the A5 north. **2)** After reaching the A5 intersection with the M69, follow the instructions from part B.2 above.

From the North West

M6 A. 1) At Junction 4a of the M6 take the M42 heading north towards Tamworth. **2)** At Junction 10 of the M42 take the A5 south towards London. **3)** After about 6.5 miles you will pass the A444 Nuneaton crossroads. MIRA Technology Park is on the left about 0.5 miles past this junction.

M6 B. 1) Continue south on the M6 to Junction 3. **2)** Take the A444 north into Nuneaton. **3)** After reaching Nuneaton, follow signs for the A47 Hinckley until you reach the A47 T-junction with the A5. **4)** Turn left onto the A5 towards Tamworth and then straight-on at the roundabout. MIRA Technology Park is then on your right after about 0.5 miles.

M40. 1) At Junction 15 of the M40 take the A46 north towards Coventry and the M69. **2)** Stay on the A46 around Coventry, following signs for the M69 Leicester (the A46 eventually merges onto the M69). **3)** At Junction 1 of the M69 take the A5 north towards Tamworth, then follow instructions from 'M1 from north - B.2 above'.

M5. 1) At Junction 4a of the M5 join the M42 north. **2)** At Junction 10 of the M42 take the A5 south towards London. **3)** After about 6.5 miles you will pass the A444 Nuneaton crossroads. MIRA Technology Park is on the left about 0.5 miles past this junction.
