## The Events

### Day one: Fundamentals of Aerosol Science - Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November

An introduction to aerosol science which is primarily aimed at students and early career professionals to develop their knowledge and understanding about this science.

Whilst our audience will be largely academic, there is also a fair sized industry presence at this annual event.

### Day two: The Annual Aerosol Science Conference - Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> November

Our annual conference attracting delegates from academia and industry to network and have the opportunity to hear talks from experts in the field.

Our theme this year is 'Aerosol Generation and Impacts' and we have confirmed three leading plenary speakers for this event;

#### **Professor Joachim Curtius, Goethe-University Frankfurt am Main:**

*From Clusters to Atmospheric Aerosol Particles: Nucleation and Growth in the CLOUD Experiment at CERN.*

#### **Professor Andrew Bayly, University of Leeds:**

*Spray dried particle structure – understanding and engineering.*

#### **Professor Hugh Coe, The University of Manchester:**

*Properties and impacts of biomass burning aerosol over the Amazon - the latest results from the South American Biomass Burning Analyses (SAMBBA) project.*

These invited talks will be supported by additional contributed talks from our members and by a poster review in the main exhibition room.
