

THE ERNEST WHITTLE MEMORIAL PRIZE AWARD

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. The prize will consist of a cash award of £ 350 and a certificate, together with travelling expenses to attend the presentation of the award.
2. The decision to award will be taken each year by the MChemA Examinations Board, after consultation with the Examiners.
3. Only candidates who have been awarded the MChemA during the specified period will be eligible for consideration.
4. Only candidates who have passed each part of the MChemA at the first attempt will be eligible for the award.
5. The prize will only be awarded to candidates who achieve a pass mark of at least 60% in each section of each part of the examination. The Board may at its discretion award the prize to candidates who fail to meet this specific criterion, but otherwise achieve an overall pass mark of 60% or more.
6. In considering potential recipients, the Board will scrutinise the performances of those candidates who have satisfied the Examiners in the MChemA examinations and have been awarded the MChemA either in the current year or in either of the two previous years. In the case of many candidates achieving the requirements, the Prize will be awarded to the one achieving the highest marks.
7. The Board may decide in any year that no Prize will be awarded. In that event the award may be carried forward to a subsequent year, provided that a rate of not more than one award per annum is maintained.
8. The recipient will be invited to receive the prize at a luncheon, or other suitable event, as a guest of the MChemA Examinations Board.
