Guidance for Faraday Division Council Members

- 1. Attend as many Faraday Division Council meetings as you can.

- 4. Take on specific duties and deputise for the Faraday Division President as requested.
- 5. Provide input into RSC policy submissions/consultations which are relevant to members of the physical chemistry community.
- 6. Keep an eye on issues and send agenda items to the Secretary.
- 7. Engage with other Divisions/Forums/RSC Groups in respect of issues around physical chemistry, together with other parts of the RSC as appropriate.
- 8. Encourage the nomination of new members of Council, encouraging diversity in age, gender, ethnicity and subject expertise.
- 9. Encourage the nomination of suitable candidates for awards. Encourage diversity. Some awards may have membership conditions.
- 10. Encourage participation in Faraday Discussions, symposia, regional meetings and RSC Group meetings and come yourself.
- 11. Help initiate, plan and organise conferences and meetings.
- 12. Contribute to Faraday Division Strategy and the wider Royal Society of Chemistry Strategy.
