1) Welcome SP welcomed all

2) Actions from Last Meeting

Potential to arrange joint events with SCI Fine Chemicals Group as their members are mainly industrial. SP Action - to draft an invitation to industrial members to join the committee 2 general members, 1 web, industrial membership officer, 1 interaction and outreach.

OK action end Sept– create a general description flyer to advertise ourselves to potential members. Rest of committee must finish proofreading by end Sept. When flyer finalised **FH action** create a flyer through brand centre to go

with the letter (Editable free text). Get the flyer also as a PDF to circulate electronically. **OK** suggested mail flyer to top 50 chemical companies in UK.

4) Finance - As of March 2016: NP to update but not much change here particularly the new funding rules based upon group activity

NP updated the meeting on the groups finance figures. Balance £12k approx. Spending heavily at the present rate to encourage activities. Spend this year to date £773, excluding the EC element. RSC is providing £919 last year this is expected to be lower for the coming year. Expect year end to be approx. £12k. The Group needs to consider all supporting elements to ensure that money is spent on appropriately targeted specific events.

Business reserve £800 Current account £500 $\pounds 2k$ was assigned to EC for Sheelagh Campbell over the next 10 years to award an annual prize.

CLIRSPEC Summer School - £500 was provided but not used. It was agreed on 05 August 16 that the money will rollover for next year.

Also please see sections below for further discussions – sponsoring school outreach programmes with Catalyst museum (**OK**) and potential 1day seminars in the NW (Clays in regenerative medicine and Pickering stabilised emulsion polymerisation). It was agreed that the group would sponsor the Widnes even £500 but **OK** to apply for Chemistry Week funding and run the visit on Chemistry week (19 – 27 November) for more publicity. Deadline for funding application is 19^{th} August – maximum award = £750.

5) History of RSC-IPCG

Update (history kept below in italics) – Publication was discussed. Article appears as a PDF on IPCG website. More photos may be good. **SNP to add in future history** – this will be discussed hopefully at the next meeting part of the celebration 175 years.

JR has written an excellent historical account of the IPCG. The IPCG committee recommend that JR publishes it via the RSC – Chemistry News or Chemistry World.

ACTION JR Updated - JR has included all the conferences and now covers the first 20 year of the IPCG. SNP to send a copy of this to PF for comments. JR to follow up publication and confirm route forward. Need some photographs either of IPCG individuals or events to include in the article.

The committee proposed a vote of thanks to JR for preparing this excellent article.

RSC are publicising the article through Twitter and Facebook and are looking at how to get it more widely circulated. Webpage including video appears on RSC website (include link).

Action SNP add to final section to include the future of IPCG group within the article (Mid 1990s onwards) and **JR** to add section on the 1980s.

6) Update on ElectroChem

Action AMc, SNP and SH to consider a session at ElectroChem 2016, Leicester. IPCG session. Explore Industrial plenary session. Agreed £500 for speaker or studentship if required. Target area Industrial Electrochemistry. **2016 will not happen**. **Action AMc, SH and SNP** to instead consider B'ham 2017 for EC 2017.

Update from SH via email - The Sheelagh Campbell memorial prize is awarded this year to Michelle Browne from Trinity College Dublin. The paper is called

"Low-Overpotential High-Activity Mixed Manganese and Ruthenium Oxide Electrocatalysts for Oxygen Evolution Reaction in Alkaline Media" and the doi is 10.1021/acscatal.5b02069. **FH** to add to website congratulations (October). Check if Sarah/Alastair is going to the awards and send photo. **FH action** – certificate for winner **ASAP**. Send certificate to whoever is attending (Alastair or Sarah).

7) Meetings

ACTION SNP – Explosives talk. Better to use a hotel/free lecture room at Imperial College than onsite at DSTL – **SNP to follow up.** SNP – Colleague organising SADA Oxford September 2017. International meeting with explosion detection technologies. Potential to support financially.

MB - Flagship Faraday Conference. Idea that someone attends and gets ideas for next year. MB has been communicating with Ann Dixon. Possibility to manage a session in 2019 (nothing sooner) but need to find out what members want to gauge the focus of the meeting. **Ongoing**

Action JR & OK – to speak to colloids group (joint RSC/SCI) and pickering emulsion and (regenerative medicine – possibly) 1 day meeting. OK proposes a workshop in Sept 2017 as a problem solving workshop. Working title 'Technical Challenges to the commercialisation of pickering technologies' Potentially co-organised with Colloids and Emulsions group. Potential funding support of £500 - £1000. Suggestion that we focus on workshops etc to target industrial members. OK will also approach Fine Chemicals Group. Deadline for additional funding for 2017 events is 21st October. Proposal that the funding is used to get speakers in.

Action MJB, OK & AMc – investigate topic and titles / lecturers for materials based regenerative medicine 1 day meeting. Investigate Glasgow to hold this in spring 2017. MB to chat with speakers. Need to start looking at dates. MB to sort out dates. Ongoing.

Future meetings (please see sponsorship section above) – Clinical and Raman spectroscopy summer school in the Lakes - £500 sponsor from IPCG – July 2016 $(12^{th} - 15^{th})$
