CONCEPT AND FORMAT OF THE VALENCIA FLUORINE DAYS



We are pleased to announce the 3rd International Symposium on Organofluorine Compounds in Biomedical, Materials and Agricultural Sciences (“Valencia Fluorine Days”), to be held in Valencia, Spain, from May 20-24, 2012. This event follows those previously celebrated in Perugia, Italy (2001 and 2010) as a result of collaborations between different European research groups, and now intends to expand and establish regularity in the forthcoming years on other sites around the world.

Organofluorine compounds are nowadays essential in the design of new bioactive molecules for the development of pharmaceuticals and agrochemicals. In addition, other applications in areas such as material sciences, solvents, fluorous chemistry or radiochemistry (18F-radiolabelled compounds for positron emission tomography experiments) have increased the interest in fluorinated molecules, in both academia and industry environments.

The aim of this Symposium is to provide an overview of current directions in all aspects of fluorine chemistry. The Symposium is addressed primarily to scientists of the “Organofluorine Community”, although it will also open to those interested in the potential of fluorine in their own research. An attendance of 100-150 chemists is expected, and the scientific program will include plenary lectures (45 min), invited lectures (30 min) and poster presentations. A social program, highlighting the outstanding charm of the City of Valencia, will be organized for the conference attendees and accompanying persons.
