WSF attracts members, and thus expertise, from many sectors within the water community: environmental consultancies, utility companies, industrial treatment companies, academia and regulatory bodies.

The broad **AIM** of the WSF is to promote the professional and scientific interests of members and to advise and influence, in the public interest, on the application of chemistry in water-related industries.

- Contributing to consultation documents from the UK and EC
