This was a scientifically successful, interesting and informative conference with presentations on a range of topics including biosensor technologies, applications and informatics. Presentations were by invited speakers and young researchers. Attendance total was 39, including a number of student and complimentary bursaries.

Comments	12-13 December 2016. A conference in the AAMG's long standing annual Monitoring Ambient Air conferences. Recent developments in monitoring technologies were also covered. Total attendance was 81 with three exhibitors. Approximately a fifth of the delegates were from overseas.
