Topics for presentations in any format may be results, reviews or plans and may have already been presented elsewhere.

Prizes will be awarded, focusing on quality of science and clarity of communication.

The programme will include a careers-orientated keynote presentation and a tour of Syngenta's cutting edge facilities at Jealott's Hill International Research Centre.
