Abstract Preparation and Submission

Abstracts are invited for oral and poster presentation. Abstracts will be subjected to a stringent review process and will only be accepted based on their merits.

The abstract must not exceed 1 page A4 and should be sent by email as a file attachment to The Solar Energy Society (UK-ISES) Secretariat at info@uk-ises.org.

Instructions for abstract submission, identifying the author for correspondence, selected conference theme and indicating preference for poster or oral presentation are given on the PVSAT web-site, www.pvsat.org.uk. The abstract should identify paper title, names and affiliations of all authors, purpose of the work, scientific approach, relevance, summary of the results and conclusions.

This year the organising committee has decided that there are four options available for delegates presenting at the conference to give as much flexibility as possible:

- Submission of a full 4 page manuscript
- Submission of an extended 1-2 page abstract
- Submission of a digital copy of the oral presentation delivered
- Submission of a digital copy of the poster presentation delivered

Full paper manuscripts and extended abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings.

Awards will be made for the best poster presentations and the best full papers submitted.
