REACH Registration: Are you ready for 2018?

Who should attend?

Any company manufacturing or importing a substance between 1 and 100 tonnes per year may have an obligation to register under REACH by 31 May 2018. This day will be of particular interest to potential registrants of substances not previously registered; as well as first-time registrants of substances already registered by other manufacturers or importers. Remember, it's not just the Lead Registrant who needs to submit a dossier; each registrant must make their own submission to the European Chemicals Agency.

You'll get the most from the day if you have attended a **REACH – the Basics** or a **REACH and small businesses** workshop, or have some understanding of REACH and how registration affects your company.

Why attend?

The final REACH registration deadline on 31 May 2018 applies to phase-in substances manufactured and imported in the 1-10 and 10-100 tonnes per year bands. ECHA expects that up to 70,000 dossiers will be submitted – significantly more than were prepared for the previous deadlines. You may be one of the many registrants going through the process for the first time.

- ✓ Differentiate between substances registered in 2010/13 and those to be registered for the first time
