

Analytical Biosciences Group ECRM – Department of Chemistry, University of York

Travel information

The ECRM is to be held in the main block of the Chemistry Department at the University of York, Heslington Campus.

Public transport and walking

The number 66 bus runs regularly from the train station to the University, taking approximately 15 minutes. The bus can also be caught on Merchantgate or the Barbican. Once on Heslington West campus, get off at the library stop and walk up the hill towards the library. The Chemistry department will be signposted.

The distance can also be walked in approximately 45 minutes (from the train station). A taxi from the station will cost approximately £6-7

Driving

From the A64, we recommend taking the exit signposted for Grimston Bar / University and following the A1079 to the University, due to current roadworks on the A19 (the route normally advised by SatNavs). You should aim for Heslington West campus.

During the Easter break, parking should be relatively easy on campus. The nearest Pay and Display car park to the Chemistry department is Campus North, near the STEM Learning centre.

On campus

The Chemistry Department is a 3-4 minute walk from the University library and will be signposted. The reception is located in A-block, and the meeting will be held in rooms A101/A102 just behind reception.

Conference dinner venue

The conference dinner will be held at Walmgate Alehouse (Walmgate). This is close to city centre hotels and an approximately 30 minute walk from the University. You can take the number 66 bus to the Edinburgh Arms / Fishergate stop, from where Walmgate Alehouse is a 5-10 minute walk.
