

**JEYA HENRY, PROFESSOR OF HUMAN NUTRITION  
AT OXFORD BROOKES, WILL PRESENT THE BINSTED LECTURE**

## **GLOBAL NUTRITION – FOOD SECURITY AND FEEDING THE WORLD**



**This year's IFT Binsted Lecture will be presented by Jeya Henry - Professor of Human Nutrition, Oxford Brookes University on November 10<sup>th</sup> at the SCI Lecture Theatre, 14/15, Belgrave Square, LONDON, SW1X 8PS.**

*The lecture will start at 6.00 pm and will be followed by our usual networking buffet.*

Professor Jeya Henry initially trained as a Food Technologist and subsequently obtained his MSc & PhD in Nutrition at the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine. He is currently the Head of Food Sciences and Nutrition at Oxford Brookes University and Director of the Functional Food Centre in Oxford. Professor Henry was a board member of the UK Food Standards Agency between 2000-2003. He regularly acts as a consultant to WHO, UNICEF & FAO, Asian Development on aspects of food & Nutrition and has presented over 200 lectures around the world. He recently delivered the plenary lecture on Nutrition at the World potato congress in New Zealand. He has published over 150 papers and edited 5 books.

World hunger is real. Every day an estimated billion people go to bed hungry. Although we produce adequate cereals, legumes and oil seeds to provide every human being in the world with 3,500 kcal per day, billions starve, as they are unable to purchase adequate amount of food. Protein energy malnutrition, vitamin A, iron and iodine deficiencies affect a large segment of our world population.

Some of the issues discussed in the lecture include:

- How can we eradicate malnutrition, especially micronutrient deficiencies?
- How can we ensure that adequate food is available to feed the growing population?
- How can we use food technology, bio technology and nutritional science to improve global health?

## How to Get to SCI – 14/15, Belgrave Square, SW1X 8PS



Belgrave Square can be reached on foot from Hyde Park Corner, Sloane Square and Victoria Stations within 8-15 minutes. Approximate journey times between Heathrow Airport and Hyde Park Corner are 45 minutes, Gatwick Airport and Victoria 35 minutes. Most mainline train stations take 20-25 minutes. For those who need to bring a car, there is a multi-storey car park in Kinnerton Street (2 minutes by foot).

### Rail

Victoria Station has mainline trains to Clapham Junction and Southern England including Gatwick Airport. Also Tube (Underground) to Euston, Kings Cross, St. Pancras and Paddington mainline stations. For information on train times and operators call National Rail Enquiries on +44 (0)8457 48 49 50.

### Tube

Green Park on the Piccadilly, Jubilee and Victoria Lines provides a tube connection direct to Waterloo mainline station and Eurostar Services for Brussels, Paris and beyond. Knightsbridge and Hyde Park Corner on the Piccadilly Line provide a service direct from Heathrow Airport (which can also be reached via Paddington by Heathrow Express).

### Bus

National Express Services operate from Victoria Coach Station on long distance routes. Many Red Bus routes serve Hyde Park Corner or Grosvenor Place.
