Young Scientist Travel Grant Application (Optional): Limited to 1 Page

If you are seeking a travel grant (which is subject to limited availability based on the quality of the abstract and demonstrated motivation) to attend the conference, it is important to include a section comprised of two parts:

Motivation [300-350 words]

- The significance of your research project's contribution to the field and its specific relevance to the conference theme.
- Your career goals and how attending the conference will benefit your professional development.
- Any previous research experience or achievements relevant to the conference.
- Financial constraints that would otherwise limit your ability to attend.

Tentative Budget

Estimate the total cost of your travel, accommodation, dinner ticket, and other expenses, and indicate how much funding you are requesting from the grant and how much you can cover from other sources.
