

## Travel Grants

The awards consist of three Travel Bursaries worth £300 each to assist with travel costs, to support the applicant's attendance at the meeting.

If you are interested in attending the RSC Chemical Nanoscience & Nanotechnology Symposium 2023 but you need financial assistance, please consider submitting an application for a travel bursary.

Before applying, please read the following guidance notes to help you complete the application.

### Eligibility Criteria

#### Career Stage

- Postgraduate students and early career researchers (academia and industry)
- Up to 10 years after completion of first degree, or 10 years after starting a first position in science or engineering

#### Additional Information

- RSC member
- Presenting their work either orally or as a poster at the conference
- Preference will be given to those who have not previously received a travel award

- 1) a statement on how the bursary will support you to participate in the symposium. Applicants should also detail the potential impact and benefits arising from attending this conference (500 words),
- 2) abstract submitted to the conference,
- 3) short CV (with the date of the award of PhD if applicable) and
- 4) a reference letter, normally provided by the candidate's supervisor.
