Presentation competition

- To register a team for the presentation competition please [email the registration form to Charlotte Still](#) as soon as possible as there is a **limit of 5 teams**. Ensure you include the name of your “heroine of science” as these will be allocated on a **first come first served basis**. If somebody has already been selected by another team then a different woman will need to be chosen.
- Your team will need to deliver a **10 minute presentation** about one heroine of science and answer at least 2 questions about their presentation.
- Teams should contain **3-4 students** and the students may be from **years 9-11**.
- Presentations can include the use of props.
- Presentations need to be sent to Charlotte by email **by Friday 11 November 2016**.
- Judges to be confirmed.

Poster competition

- Any students **not** taking part in the presentation competition can instead enter the poster competition.
- The poster should be about any heroine of science and be **A4 in size**.
- This competition is open to students in **years 9-13**.
- Posters need to be sent in advance to Charlotte [by email](#) or by post to Blackpool Sixth Form College, Blackpool Old Road, Blackpool FY3 7LR. Posters must arrive **by Friday 11 November 2016**. Posters should not be brought on the day of the event.
- Please also confirm [by email](#) whether you will be attending the event or just sending a poster.
- Judges to be confirmed.

Travel:

UTC Warrington is conveniently situated in Warrington town centre, close to the Warrington Wolves Halliwell Jones Stadium. The college is only two minutes' walk from the Warrington Bus Interchange and from Warrington Central Train Station for those travelling by public transport.
