

Travel Grants

The awards consist of two travel grants of £500 each to assist with travel, subsistence or conference registration fees. These provide funds to support the applicant's attendance at the meeting.

Before applying, please read the following guidance notes to help you complete the application.

Eligibility Criteria

Career Stage

- Postgraduate students and early career researchers (academia and industry)
- Up to 10 years after completion of first degree, or 10 years after starting a first position in science or engineering

Additional Information

- RSC member
- Presenting their work either orally or as a poster at the conference
- Preference will be given to those who have not previously received a travel award

- 1) a statement on how the bursary will support you to participate in the symposium. Applicants should also detail the potential impact and benefits arising from attending this conference (500 words),
- 2) abstract submitted to the conference,
- 3) short CV (with the date of the award of PhD if applicable),
- 4) a reference letter, normally provided by the candidate's supervisor and
- 5) proof of RSC membership.
