Guidance and Conditions for Bursary Applications

Who is eligible?

Applications are welcomed from any PhD student studying at an academic institution irrespective of their nationality. Applicants should be a member of SURCAT or should become a member to be able to apply for the bursary.

Holders of bursaries are expected to present a poster describing their PhD project.

Holders of bursaries are required to submit a brief 500 words report on the experience and knowledge acquired during the Catalysis Summer School.

Applications **must be** endorsed by the student's supervisor.

What is the maximum value of each bursary?

The bursary covers the registration fee, lunches, tea & coffee and conference dinner but not accommodation.

What is the closing date for applications?

21st April 2024.

How should successful bursary holders register for the Summer School?

Successful bursary applicants must confirm their attendance to Dr Iggo by 21st May 2024 who will register them for the Summer School on receipt of their acceptance email. Bursary holders should book accommodation through the on-line store but should **not** register through the store.
