Biological and Medicinal Chemistry Online Symposium for Postgraduates

The **Biological and Medicinal Chemistry Sector** (BMCS) of the Royal Society of Chemistry will be hosting its fourteenth postgraduate symposium for PhD students and postdoctoral workers researching in biological or medicinal chemistry and related areas. The event will be held **online** on **Friday 11th December 2020**. Researchers working in these areas are invited to participate.

The meeting will be run online from 10 am – 3.30 pm and the day will consist of 10 oral presentations delivered live (8 student and 2 keynote). Each 15 minute student talk will be followed by 5 minutes for questions.

In each session there will be a 20 minute keynote talk from an industrial or academic chemist.

In addition, the meeting's popular poster session will also transfer online. Posters will be hosted on the conference website in the run-up to the meeting and there will be an opportunity to interact with the poster presenters through Twitter or email throughout the week.

The BMCS judges will be awarding prizes to participants. There will be prizes of **£500** for the best oral presentation and of **£250** for the best poster. These will be announced at the end of the day.
