First Your Bus 66 connects the University (alight at Heslington Hall) with the city centre / train station in a ca. 20 min trip. Buses run roughly every 10 mins.

Bicycle


The University of York is connected to a number of cycle paths, and cycle storage is available in the Department of Chemistry.

Taxi

A journey by taxi from the station costs approximately £8. Ask to be dropped off at the Alcuin College taxi stand.

Car

We recommend drivers approach the Green Chemistry Centre from the junction of the A64 and A1079 on the east of the city, from where the University (Heslington West Campus) is signposted. You will be required to use one of the pay and display car parks around campus. Carpark North is nearest (350m) and is accessed via Siwards Way, off University Rd. The Department of Chemistry is signposted from the footpath at the east side of the car park. There is also parking for blue badge holders off Alcuin way.
