Please arrive at the Royal Academy of Arts for 7.30pm. The evening includes food, music and a private viewing of the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition and ends at 10pm. Food and drinks will be served until 9:30pm.

Tickets and cloakroom

Please note the following additional security arrangements:

- Please bring your emailed ticket with you, preferably on your phone to avoid unnecessary printing.
- If you have any difficulty displaying your ticket on your phone, don't worry - just speak to a member of staff at the entrance who will have a list of all guests attending.
- Tickets are non-transferable and will be checked at the door.
- One ticket will be issued per group, showing the name of the main invitee along with the number of guests joining them on the evening.
- Cloakroom facilities will be available until 10.15pm at the Royal Academy of Arts.

Dress code

Please note that the dress code is 'black tie optional'. The avoidance of doubt, we expect most guests to be wearing black tie, suits, long dresses, or cocktail dresses.

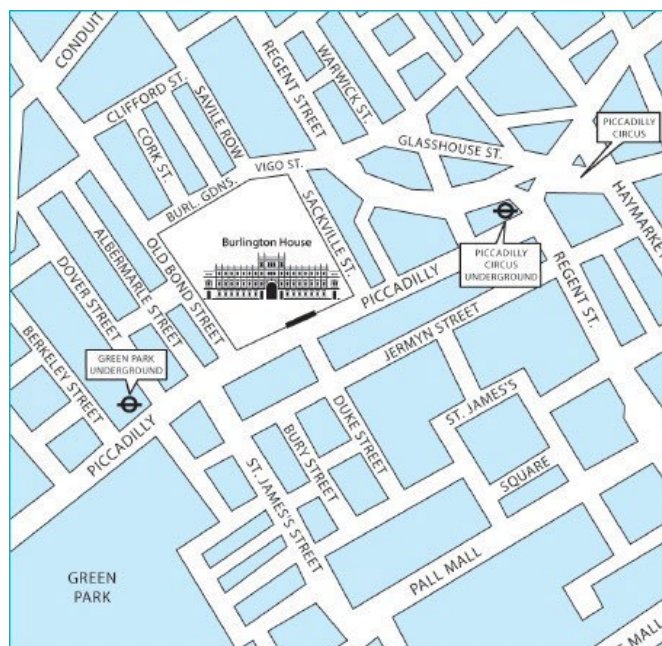

How to find us

The Royal Academy of Arts and Royal Society of Chemistry are located in Burlington House on Piccadilly, London. The nearest underground stations are Piccadilly Circus and Green Park.

Burlington House is on the north side of Piccadilly midway between Piccadilly Circus and Green Park underground stations, opposite the Fortnum and Mason department store. Entrance to the Royal Academy of Arts and the Royal Society of Chemistry is via the courtyard.



By train:

A train strike has been announced on national rails services for Thursday 20th July, so if you were planning on travelling into London by train, we request that you check your travel arrangements in advance.

Transport for London (TFL) are not currently affected and so underground trains and buses in London should still be running, though there might be some disruption to overground trains in London.

It is easy to get to Burlington House via London Underground. You can take either the Piccadilly or Victoria line to Green Park or Piccadilly tube stations; both are a five-minute walk to the venue. If you use Green Park please leave via Piccadilly Northside and look for the Royal Academy entrance, turn left out of the station, you will see the red flags of Burlington House ahead of you.

By coach:

National Express operates a comprehensive coach service to most parts of the country from Victoria Coach Station, 164 Buckingham Palace Road, SW1W 9TP.

By car:

Please note that there is no parking at Burlington House – we recommend using public transport to get to the venue.
