International Isotope Society UK Group 21st Annual Symposium, Friday 12th October 2012

I have great pleasure in inviting you to participate in the Twenty First Annual Symposium of the International Isotope Society - UK Group. The meeting is entitled 'Synthesis and Applications of Labelled Compounds' and should be of interest to isotope users, principally in the life sciences.

Amongst the topics to be covered are: organic synthesis with carbon-14, use of tritium in ADME studies, new synthetic chemistry relevant to isotopic labelling, environmental fate and effect studies and new imaging modalities.

This year the meeting will be held at the Møller Centre (www.mollercentre.co.uk), Churchill College in Cambridge. The Møller Centre is just one mile from the M11 motorway and a short taxi ride from Cambridge railway station with its frequent express services to London Kings Cross (45 minutes), London Liverpool Street (1 hour and 15 minutes) and Stansted Airport (30 minutes). The meeting is timed to allow most UK based people to travel to and from the symposium on the same day. A list of accommodation addresses in the locality will be included in each applicant's joining instructions should anyone need to arrange overnight accommodation.

As in past years, there is an opportunity to present posters at the meeting. Please contact Professor Bill Lockley (w.lockley@surrey.ac.uk) if you would like to do so.

I do hope you will be able to attend this year and help make this meeting of the IIS-UK Group as successful as our previous ones.
