The Analysis and Simulation of Environmental Systems Research Group (www.ases.aegean.gr) of the University of the Aegean (Greece), together with the Sanitary Environmental Engineering Division (www.seed.unisa.it) of the University of Salerno (Italy) and the Imperial College London (UK), are happy to announce the organization of the 15th International Conference on Environmental Science and Technology. The conference will be held in the Island of Rhodes, Greece from 31 August to 2 September 2017.



CEST SERIES

The International Conference on Environmental Science and Technology is one of the worldwide leading environmental conferences. This biennial conference brings together engineers, scientists, researchers, students, managers and other professionals in order to address and discuss emerging environmental issues

The previous conferences have been successful, with great participation from people involved with environmental science and technology from all over the world. The 14th Conference was held in Rhodes in September 2015. The oral presentations were in total 309 and were presented in five parallel sessions. Moreover, 195 poster presentations were available to the participants. Leading academics professionals have been invited as keynote speakers for the opening session and for special sessions that were organized.

Prince Sultan Bin Abdulaziz International Prize for Water, was the Golden Sponsor of CEST2015 following the sponsorship provided in 2013. PSIPW aims to give recognition to the efforts that scientists, inventors and research organizations around the world are making in water related fields. PSIPW acknowledges exceptional and innovative work which contributes to the sustainable availability of potable water and the alleviation of the escalating global problem of water scarcity. For this reason, PSIPW awards a suite of five bi-annual prizes, covering the entire water research landscape. The foundation was presented in the plenary session, together with a speech given by the 6th Award (2014) winner.

Keynote speakers



Susan Richardson

Topic: Emerging Pollutants



Susan D. Richardson is the Arthur Sease Williams Professor of Chemistry in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at the University of South Carolina. Prior to coming to USC in January 2014, she was a Research Chemist for several years at the U.S. EPA's National Exposure Research Laboratory in Athens, GA. For the last several years, Susan has been conducting research in drinking water—specifically in the study of toxicologically important disinfection by-products (DBPs). Susan is the recipient of the 2008 American Chemical Society Award for Creative Advancements in Environmental Science & Technology, has received an honorary doctorate from Cape Breton University in Canada (2006), and was recently recognized as an ACS Fellow (2016). She also serves as an Associate Editor of *Water Research* and on the Editorial Advisory Board of *Environmental Science & Technology*, *Rapid Communications in Mass Spectrometry*, *Journal of Hazardous Materials*, *Environmental Science and Pollution Research*, and *Journal of Environmental Sciences*. Susan has published more than 130 journal articles and book chapters and has written two ongoing invited biennial reviews for the journal *Analytical Chemistry*—on Emerging Contaminants in Water Analysis and Environmental Mass Spectrometry. She has a Ph.D. in Chemistry from Emory University and a B.S. in Chemistry & Mathematics from Georgia College & State University.



Detlef Banhemann

Topic: Advanced Oxidation Processes



Prof. Dr. rer. nat. habil. Detlef Bahnemann (PhD in Chemistry TU Berlin 1981, Habilitation in Technical Chemistry Leibniz University Hannover 2012) is currently Head of the Research Unit „Photocatalysis and Nanotechnology“ at the Institute of Technical Chemistry of the Leibniz University Hannover in Germany and also Director of the Research Institute Nanocomposite Materials for Photonic Applications at Saint Petersburg State University. His main research topics include photocatalysis, photoelectrochemistry, solar chemistry and photochemistry focussed on synthesis and physical-chemical properties of semiconductor and metal nanoparticles. His more than 300 publications have been cited more than 26,000 times (h-index: 63 according to ISI).

Gerasimos Lyberatos

Topic: Solid Waste Management



Prof. Gerasimos Lyberatos is currently professor in the School of Chemical Engineering, National Technical university of Athens and a collaborating faculty member of the Institute of Chemical Engineering and High Temperature Chemical Processes (Foundation of Research and Technology Hellas). He obtained his B.S. at M.I.T. and his M.S. and Ph.D. at CALTECH (USA). His research interests are in Biochemical Engineering and Environmental Technologies for liquid and solid waste treatment and valorization. He has over 170 publications in International refereed Journals, and over 250 participations in International Conferences, 9 Chapters in books and two books. He has supervised 33 PhD theses. He has organized two International Conferences. Prof. Lyberatos is Editor of the Journal of Hazardous Materials (Elsevier), Associate Editor of Waste and Biomass Valorization (Springer), Associate Editor of GNEST and is also coordinator in a graduate programme on “Solid Waste Management” of the Hellenic Open University.
