

RSC Food Group OPEN Medal 2022-Call for Nominations



The Food Group Open Career Medal is awarded biennially for outstanding contributions to the chemical sciences in the area of food chemistry.

- The prize is sponsored by the Elsevier suite of Food Chemistry journals
- The winner receives £2000, a medal and a certificate and will be invited to present at an RSC Food Group Event.

The Food Group Senior Medal were originally established in 1987 to recognise research and/or impact in the area of food chemistry and ran for 20 years. In light of the recent innovation in food chemistry in response to the challenges to our current food system, this medal is being reinstated as the biennial Food Group Open Medal. It is open to chemists in all organisations including academia, industry, government and consultancy.

Rules:

- There are no career stage restrictions associated with this prize.
- Nominees need not be members of the RSC but may NOT nominate themselves.
- Only RSC members can nominate for this prize.
- The award will be made for the most meritorious contributions to food chemistry on the basis of:
 - Impact of nominee's research on the food sector
 - Originality of research
 - Innovation in food chemistry
 - Professional standing
 - Quality of publications and/or patents and/or software
 - Collaborations and teamwork
 - Other indicators of esteem indicated by the nominator
- Nominations open **20th June 2022**
- Nominations close **31st August 2022, 17:00 BST**
