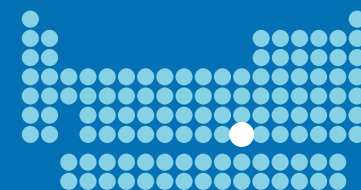
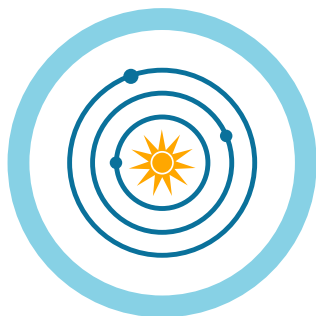

LIQUID



Due to relativistic effects copernicium is thought to be a volatile liquid that acts like a noble gas.

SHORT-LIVED



Copernicium's longest-lived isotope has a half-life of 28 seconds. It has no uses outside research.
