

## **NAME**



Copernicium was named after astronomer Nicolaus Copernicus, confirmed on his 537<sup>th</sup> birthday.

## **LIQUID**



Due to relativistic effects copernicium is thought to be a volatile liquid that acts like a noble gas.

## **SHORT-LIVED**



Copernicium's longestlived isotope has a half-life of 28 seconds. It has no uses outside research.
