

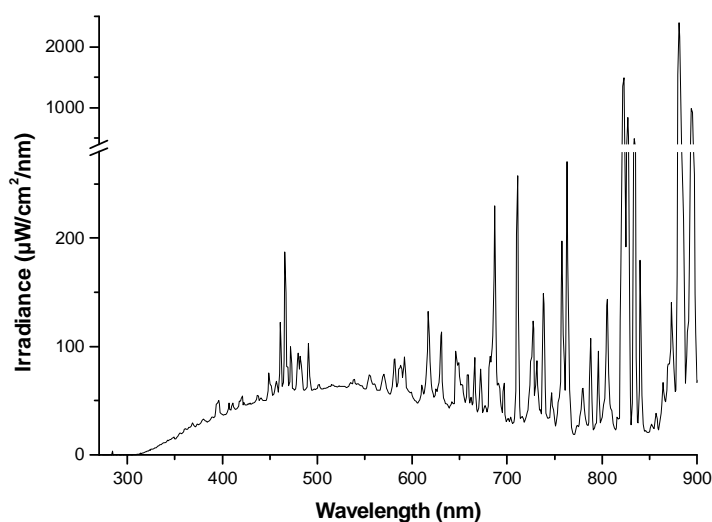

Supporting Information S1. Spectral distribution of the irradiance received by the textiles, measured using a wideband RPS900-W Rapid Portable Spectroradiometer from ILT. The total UV/Vis irradiance of 242 W/m² contained 226 W/m² of visible light and 16 W/m² of UV-A.
