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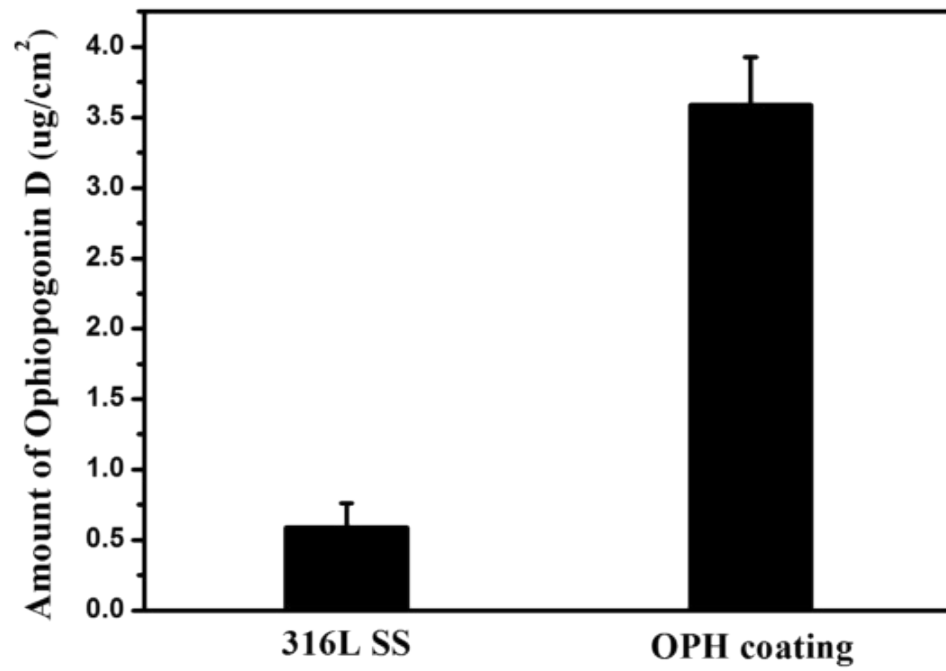


Figure S1. Quantitative characterization of Ophiopogonin D on each samples (mean \pm SD, n=5)

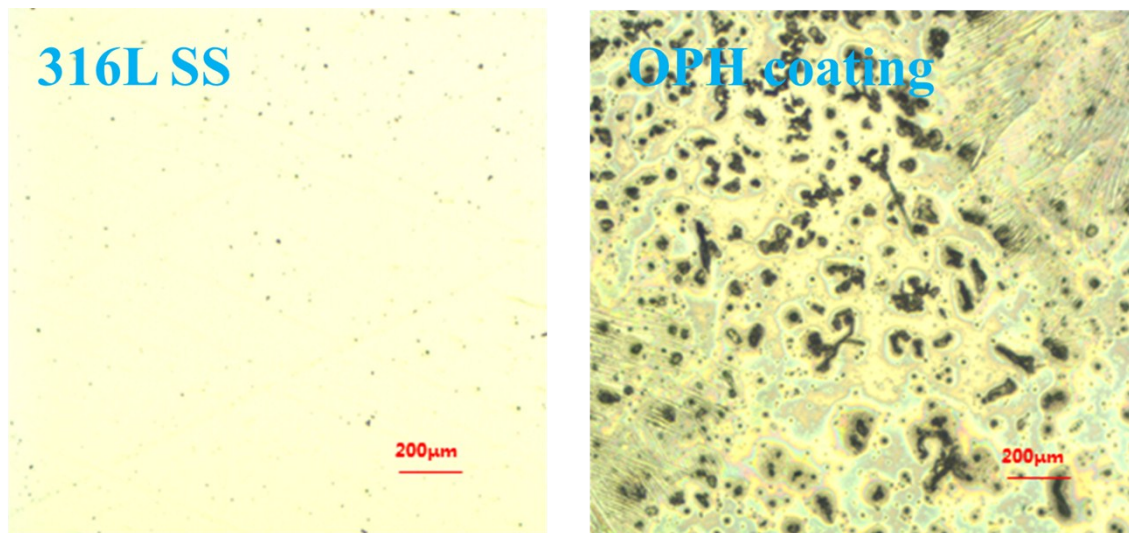


Figure S2. Optical microscopy images of OPH coating and 316L SS.
