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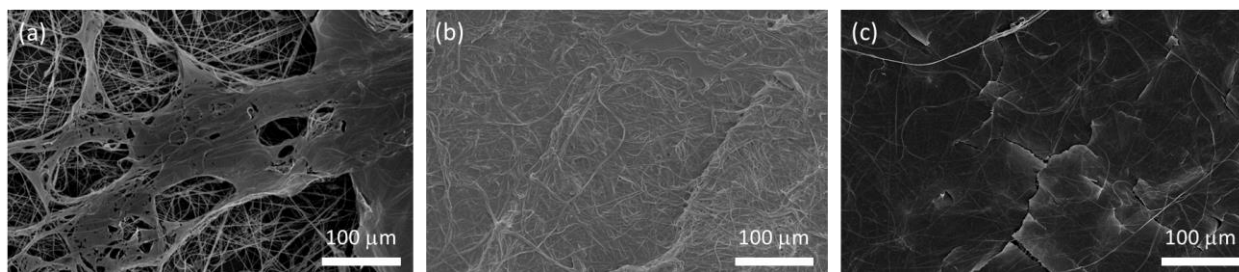


Figure S1. SEM images of PMMA-GO nanofibers using distinct adsorption times: (a) 30 min, (b) 1h and (c) 2h.
