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


Fig. SI1. ¹H NMR of POSS-(N₃)₈.




Fig. SI2. EDX of GO-alkyne and rGO-POSS.




Fig. SI3. Size distribution of GO (a) and rGO (b) in THF (0.5 mg mL⁻¹).
