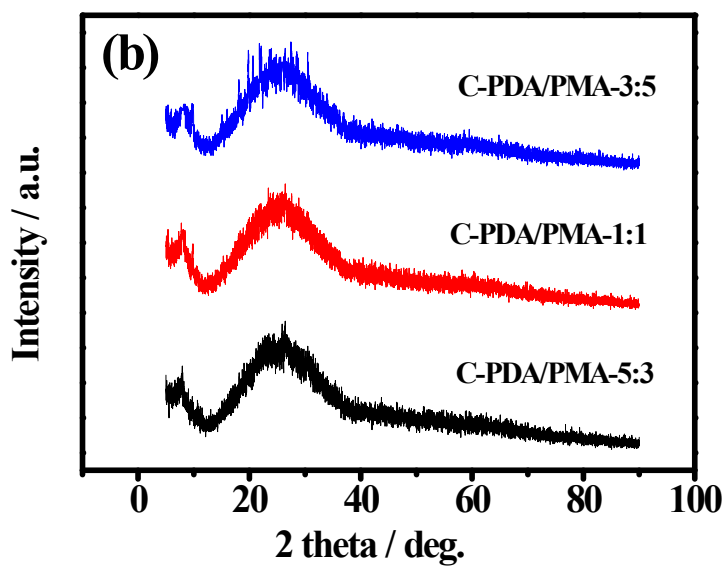
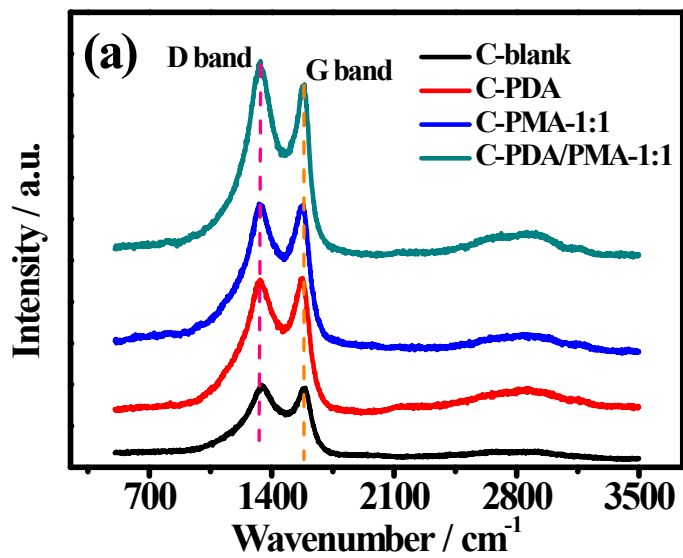


Figure S1. Raman and XRD results of carbon samples.

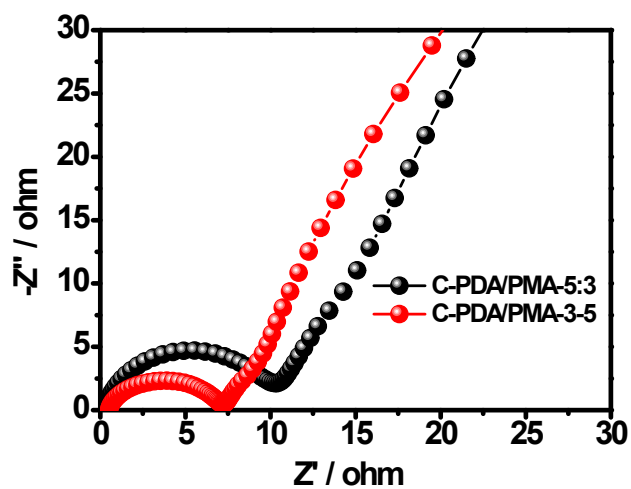
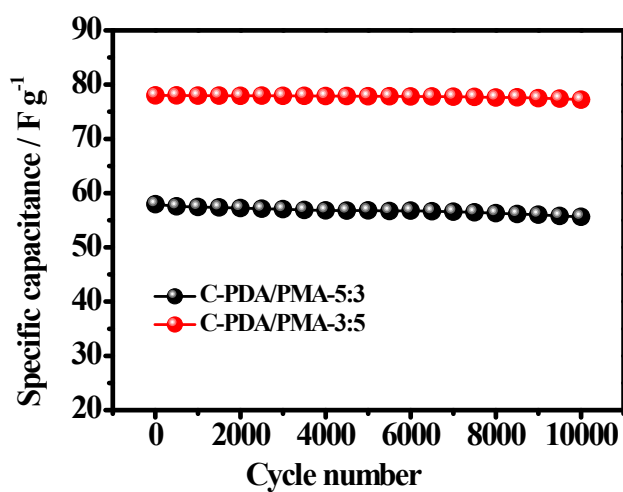
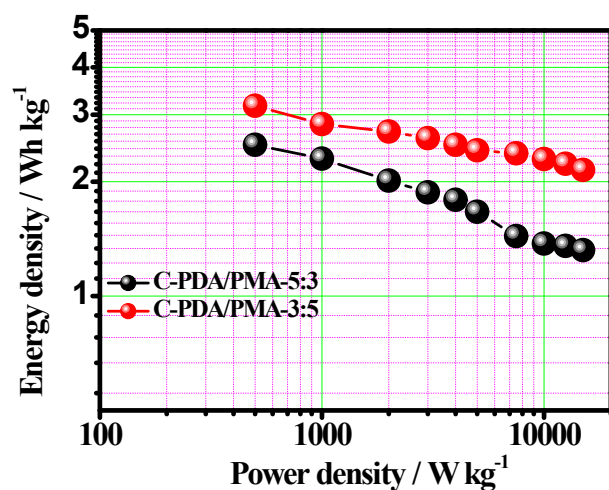
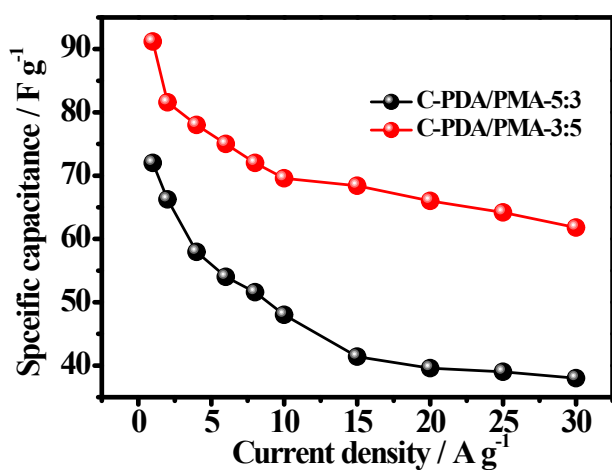
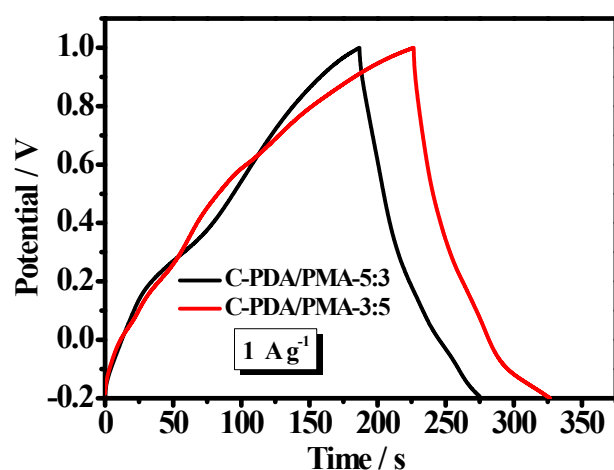
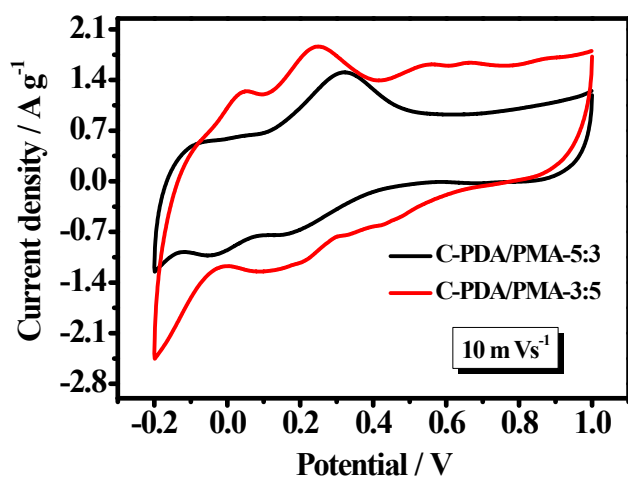


Figure S2. Electrochemical performance of the C-PDA/PMA-5:3, C-PDA/PMA-3:5 samples when tested in a two-electrode configuration.
