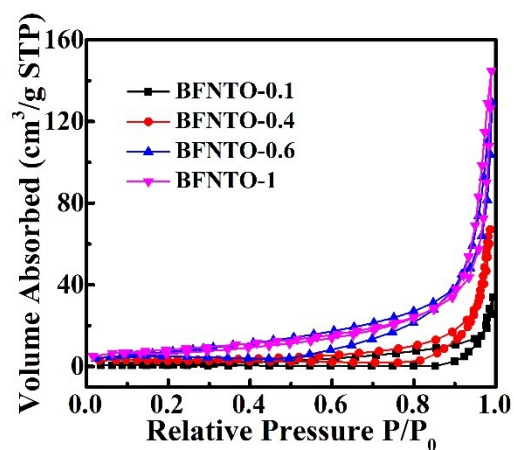


Figure S1 Adsorption-desorption isotherms of BFNTO samples.

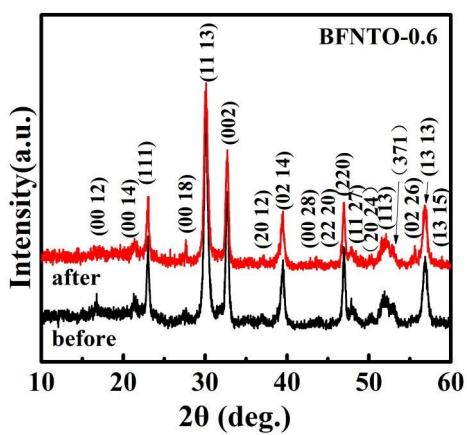


Figure S2 XRD patterns of BFNTO-0.6 sample before and after the photocatalytic RhB degradation.
