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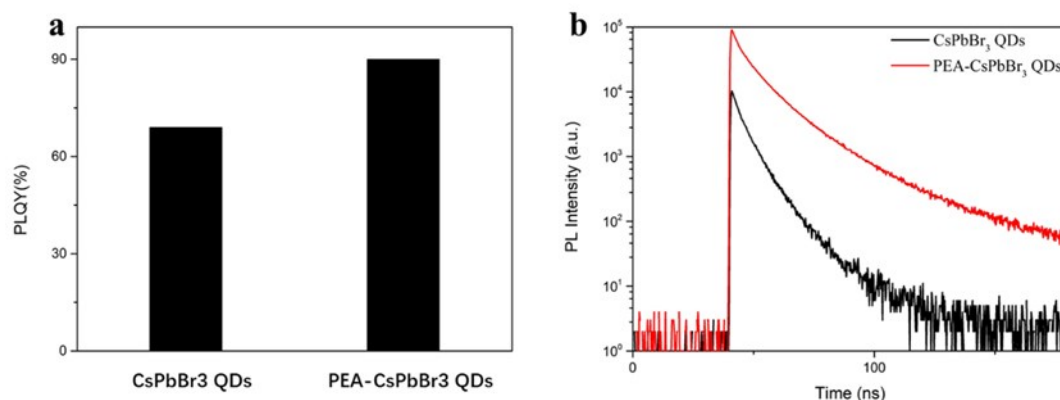

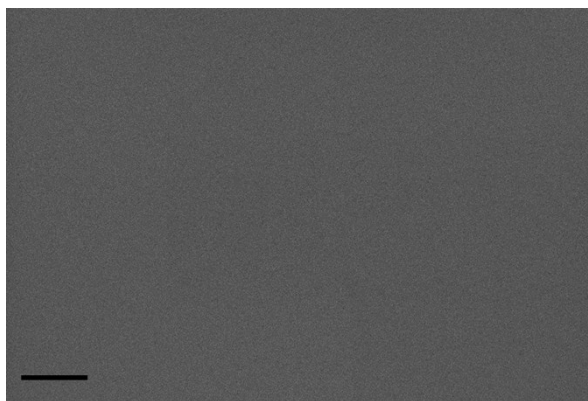


Figure S2. SEM images of 4mg/ml TOPO solution dissolved in isopropanol. Scale bar: 2um.
