Fig S1. Scheme of decapeptide synthesis via solid phase peptide synthesis followed by cleavage from Wang resin, and deprotection of amino acids.

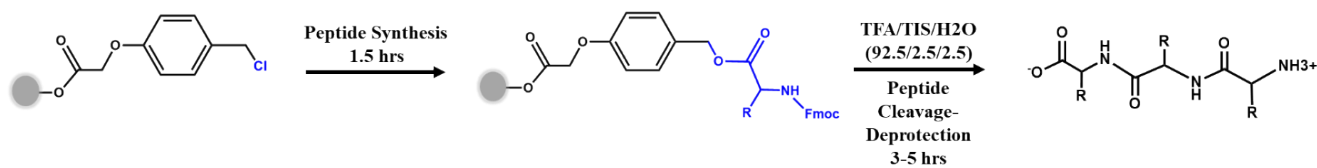


Fig S2. Structures of decapeptide positive (DP (+)) and negative (DP (-)) controls.

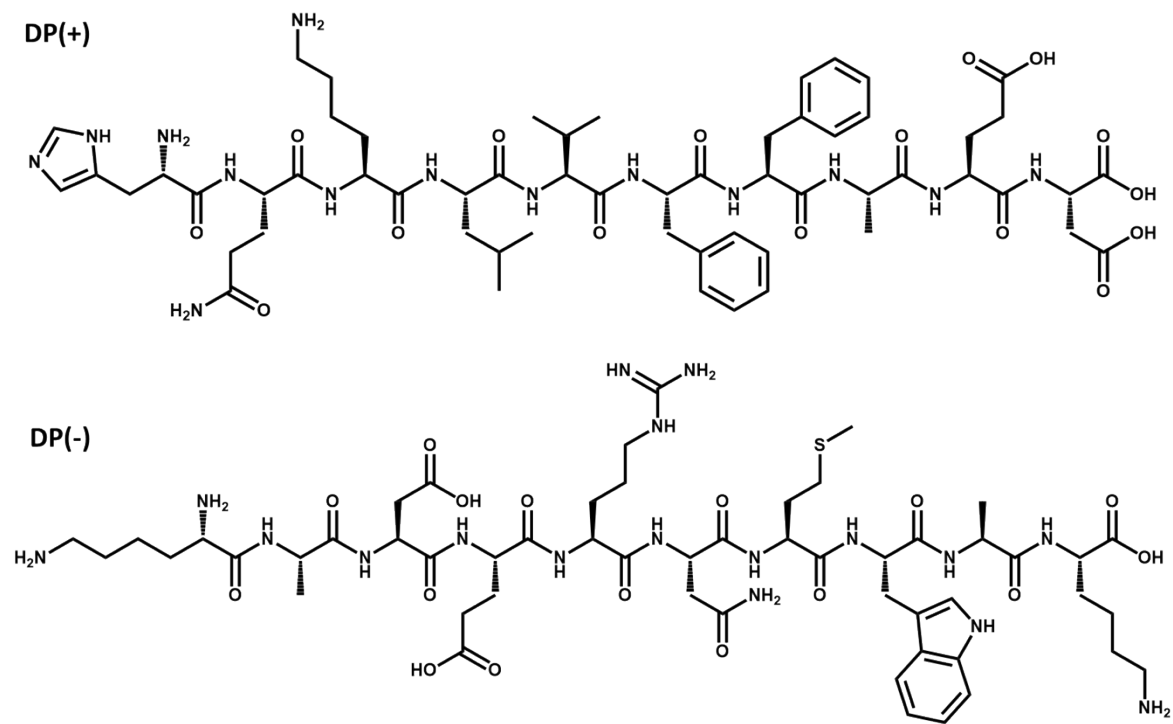


Fig. S3 ESI Mass spectra of DPI, DPII, DPIII, and DPIV.
