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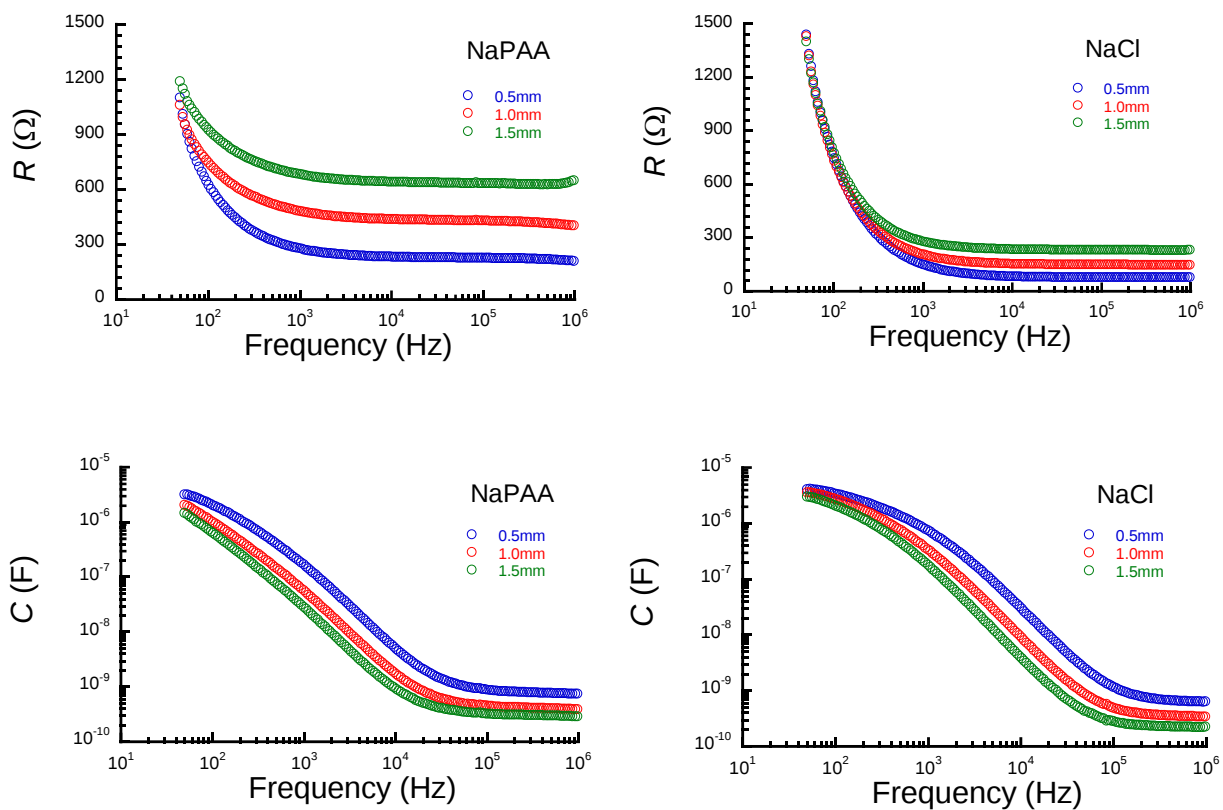


Figure S1. Frequency spectra of electric resistance and electrostatic capacitance for aqueous solutions of NaPAA and NaCl at various gap distances.

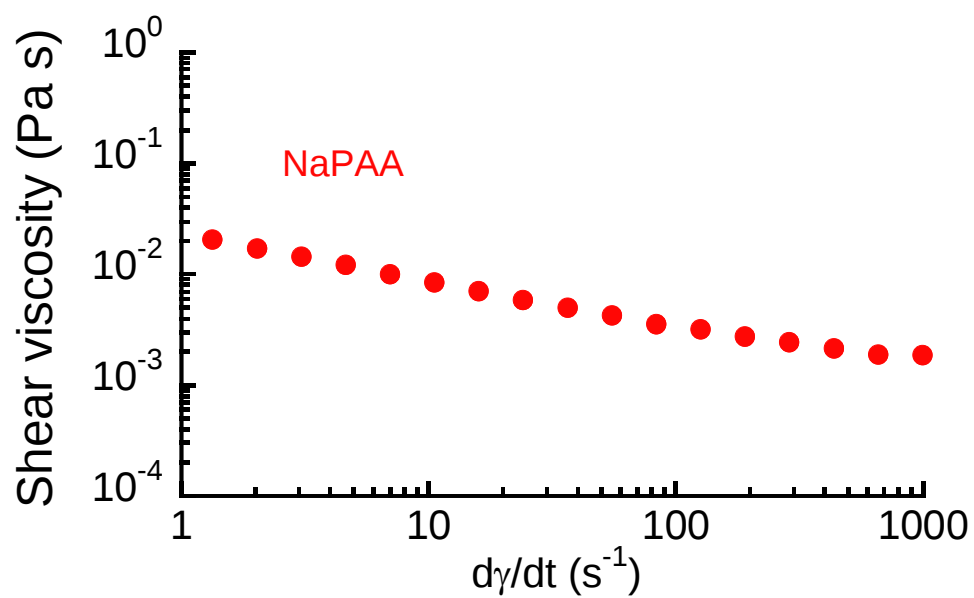


Figure S2. Flow curve for aqueous NaPAA solutions with a concentration of 0.01 wt%.
