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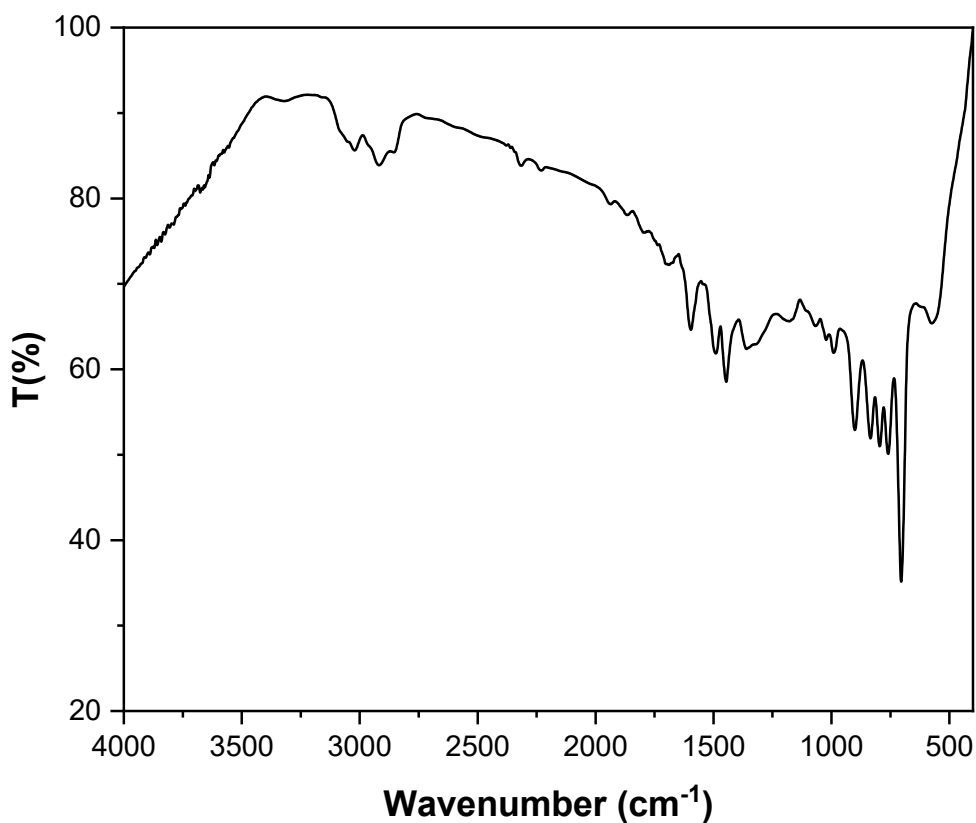


Figure S 1. FTIR spectra of poly(DVB) after adsorption of BG dye.

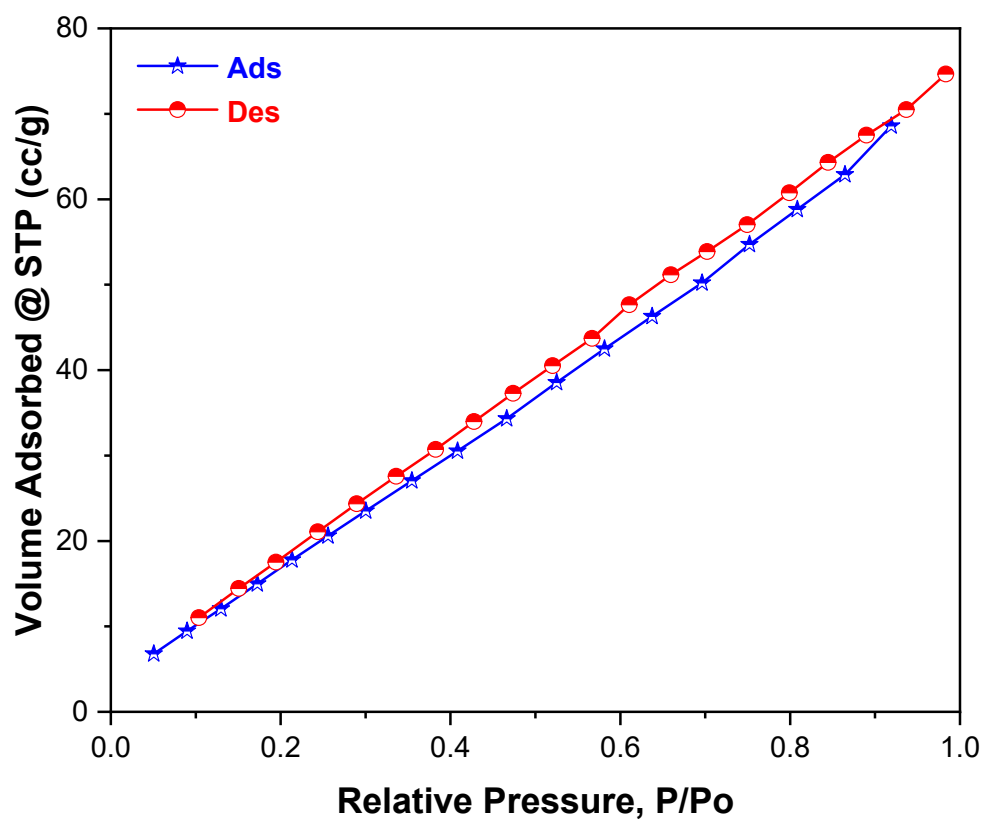


Figure S 2. BET analysis of poly(DVB) after adsorption of BG dye.

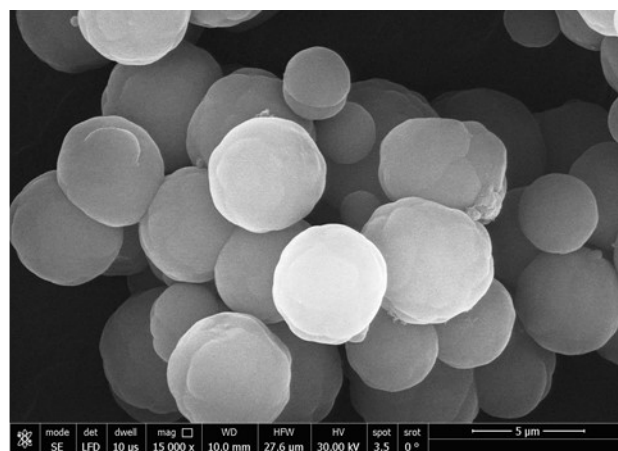
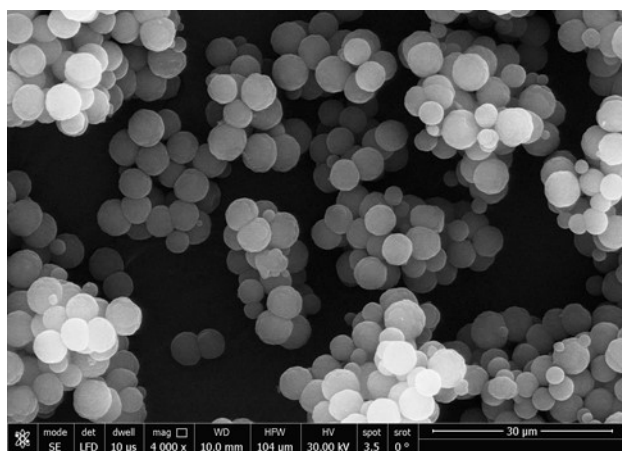


Figure S 3. SEM image of poly(DVB) after adsorption of BG dye.
