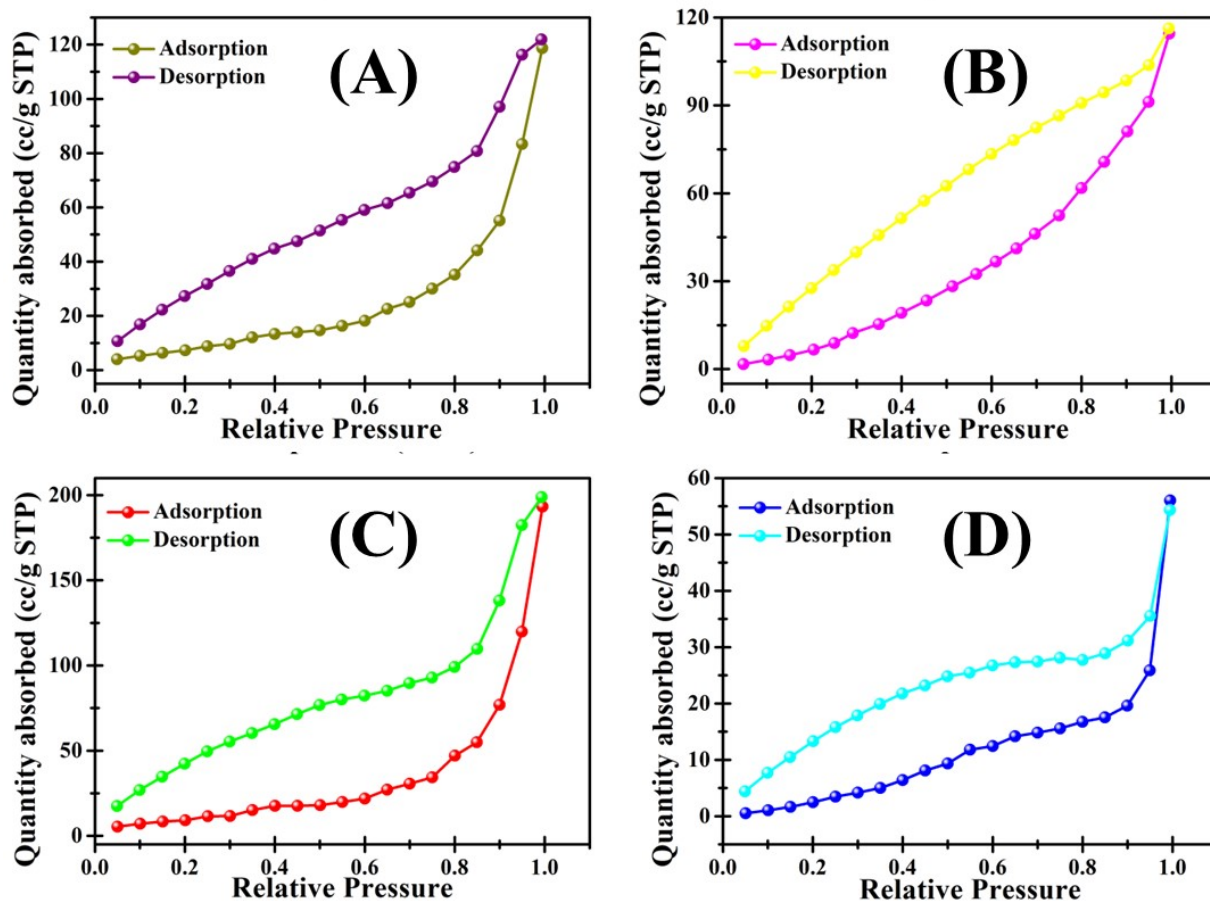

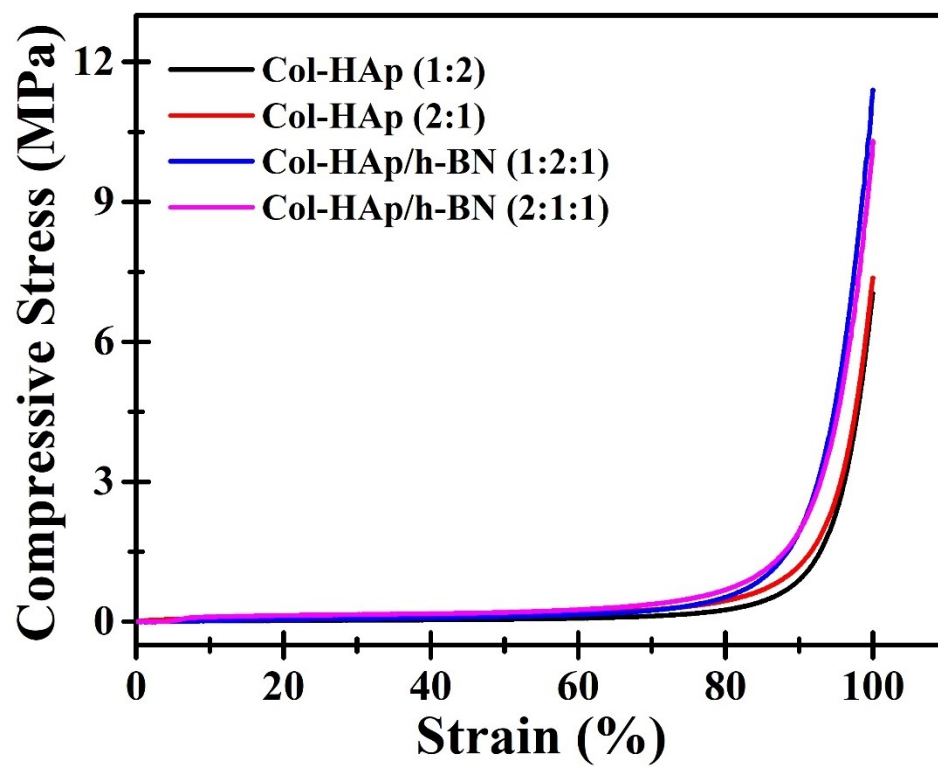


Figure S2: Compressive stress vs strain curve of different fabricated scaffold
