


Figure S1. Plot of the $\chi_M T$ vs. T for **1**.




Figure S2. Plot of the $\chi_M T$ vs. T for **3** in the heating (\triangle) and cooling mode (∇).




Figure S3. Plot of the $\chi_M T$ vs. T for **6**.




Figure S4. Packing view of **1** at 290 K.
