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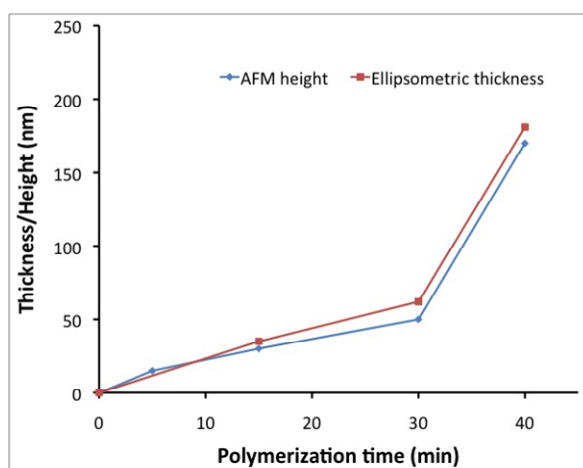


Figure. Comparison of the thickness of the PMAA brush versus the polymerization time measured both by AFM and ellipsometry.
