

Narrowly dispersed imprinted microspheres with hydrophilic polymer brushes for selective removal of sulfamethazine

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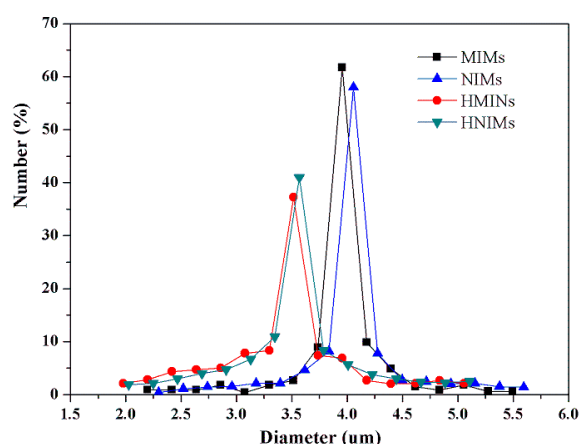


Fig. S1. Diameter distributions calculated from dynamic light scattering measurements for MIMs HMIMs, NIMs and HNIMs.

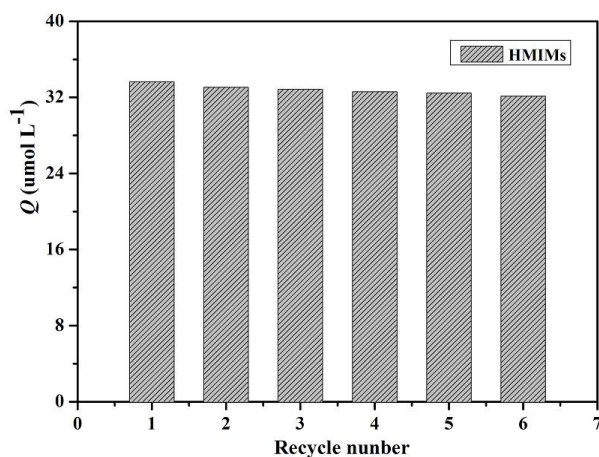


Fig. S2. Adsorption amounts of the HMIMs for SMZ in six adsorption/desorption recycles.

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
