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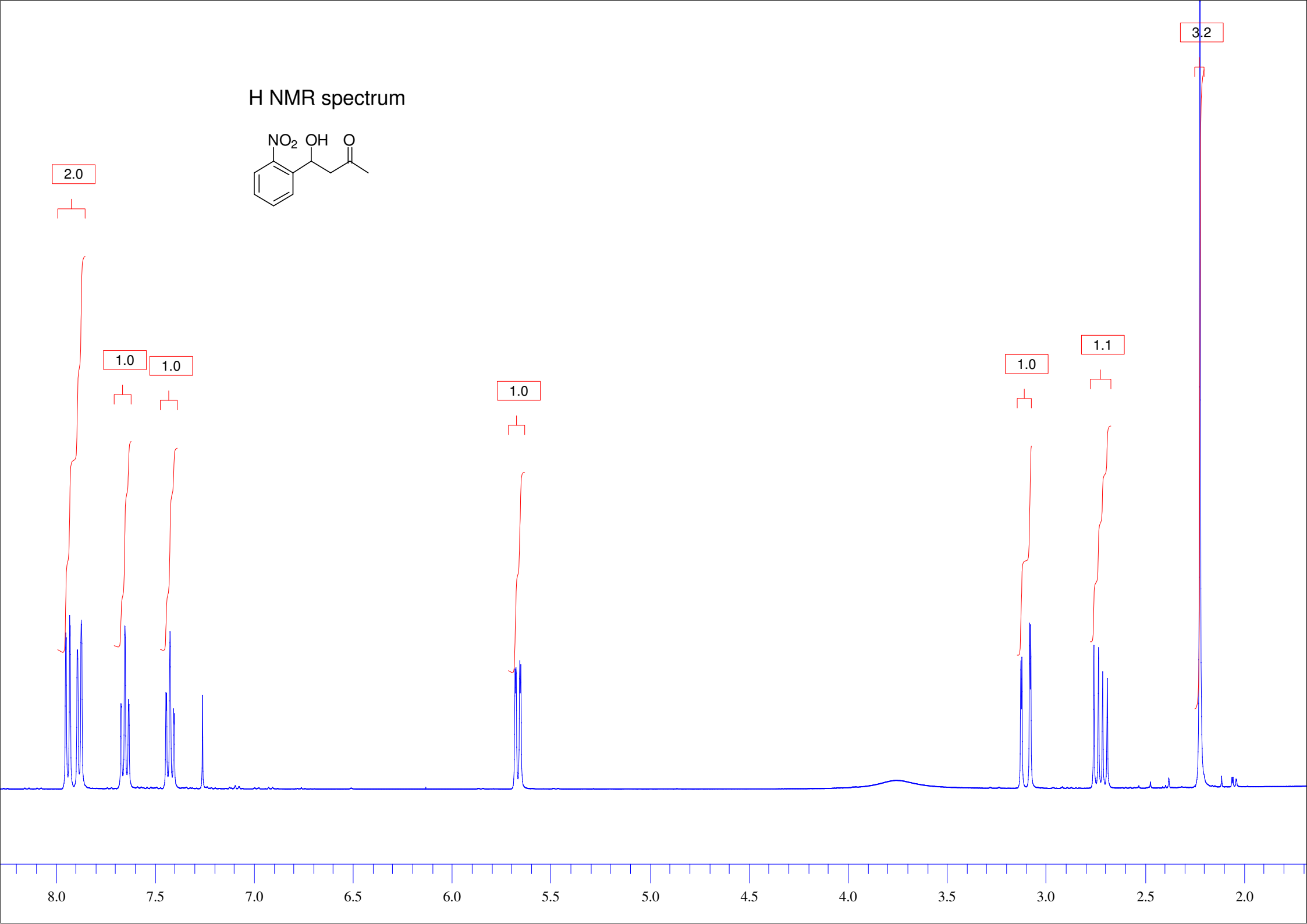
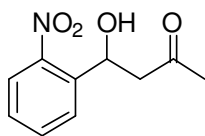
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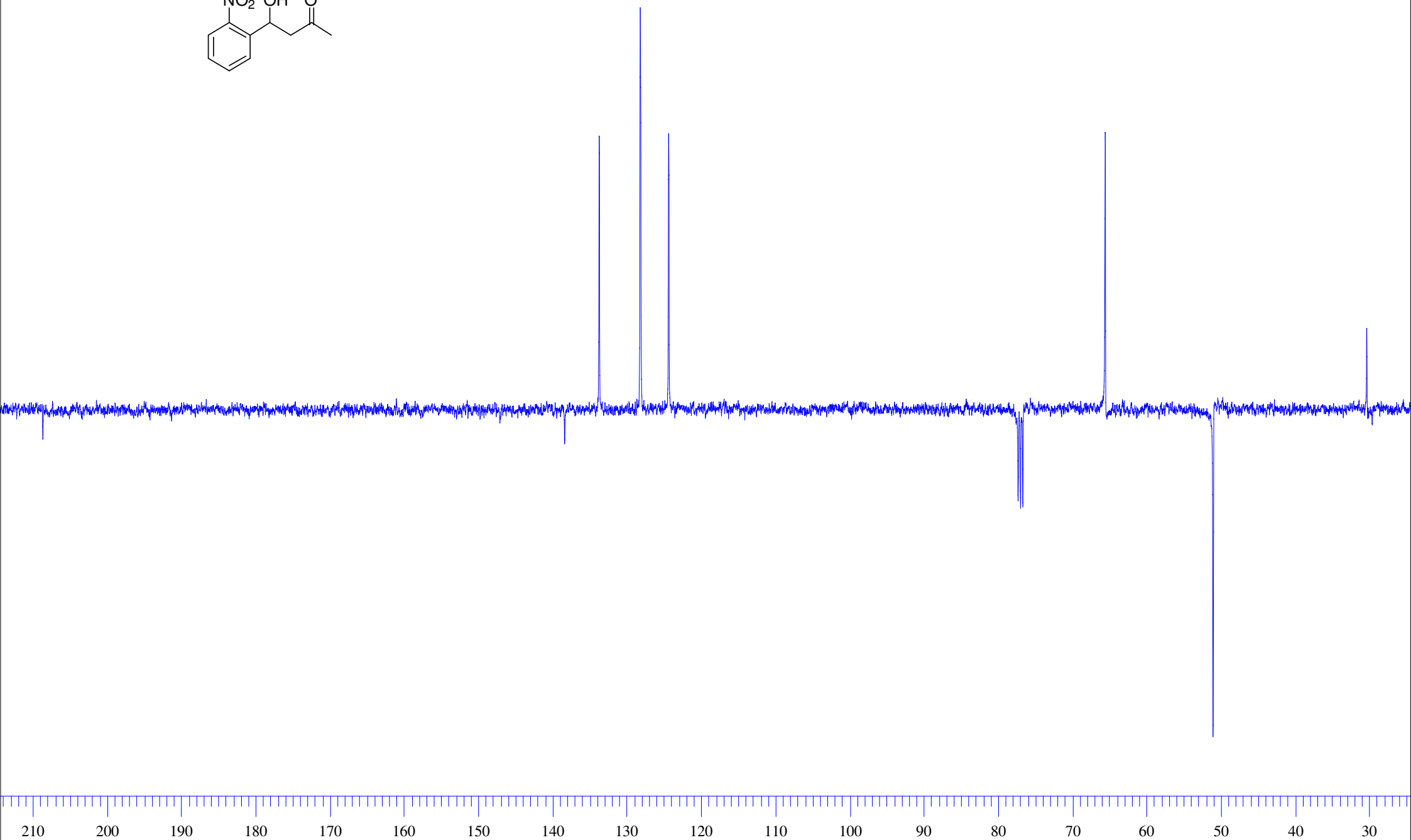
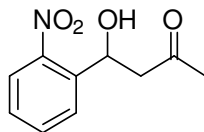
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¹H and ¹³C NMR spectra of the isolated aldol compounds

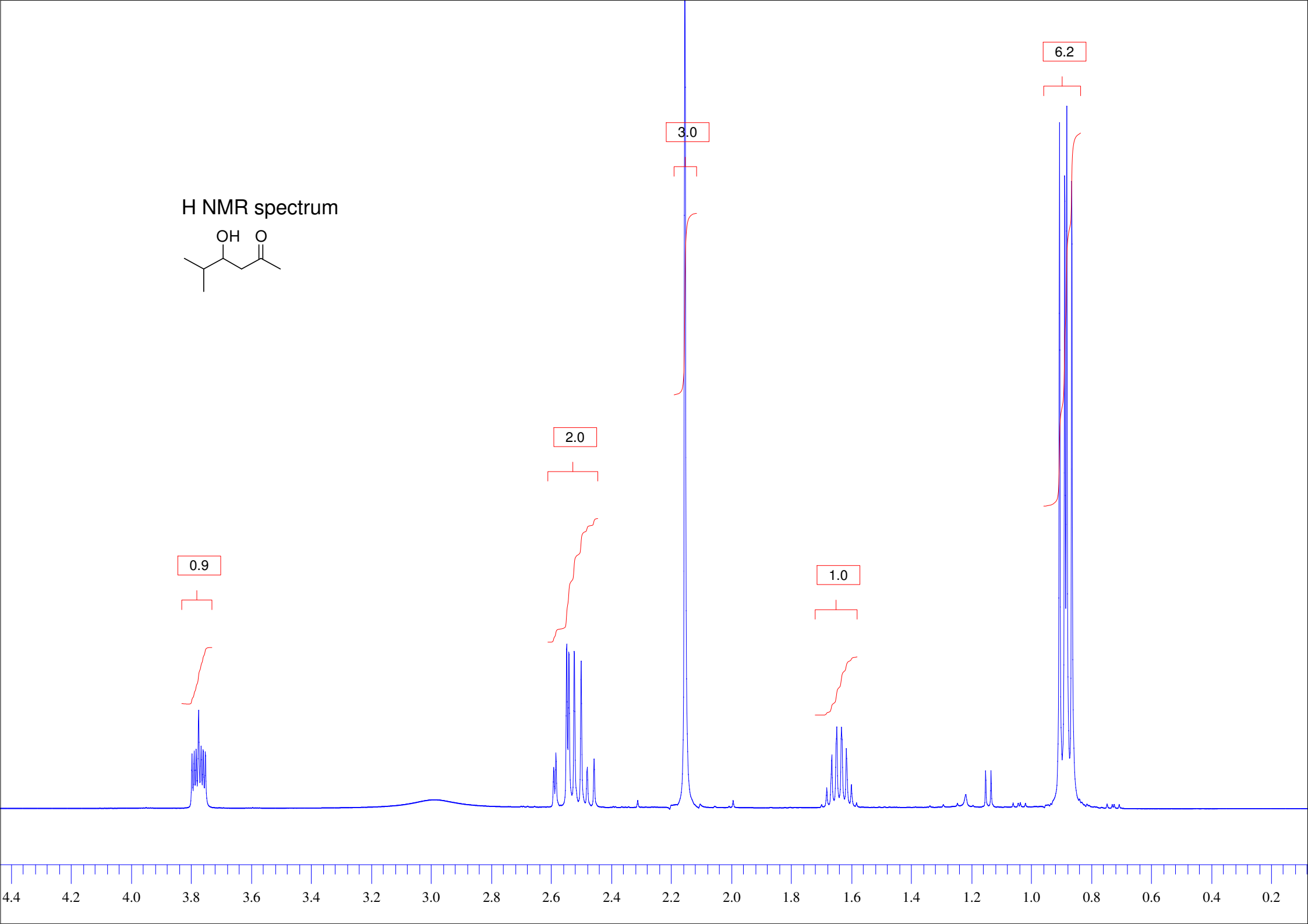
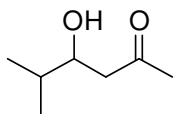
¹H NMR spectrum
