

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**Fig. S1.** Optical images representing two different scenarios of indentation processes. (**a**) Ripples are fully flattened as <sup>10</sup> illustrated in Fig. 4a. (**b**) Ripples are partially flattened as illustrated in Fig. 4c. Note: the waves seen in (**a**) are not ripples but interference fringes outside the contact, between the top of the PDMS and the glass sphere. Fig. (**b**) shows both the ripples and the interference fringes (outside the contact).
